- School Covered 30+ in Manipur, Mumbai, Gurgaon and Delhi

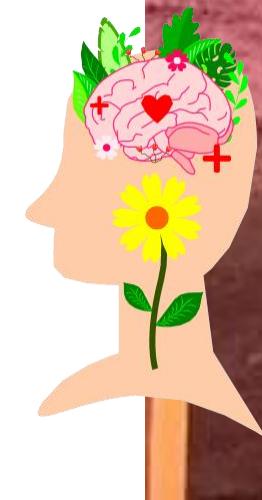
